
Charity Fundraising Event – Terms and Conditions

These Terms and Conditions apply to all participants who register to take part in an event through Run For Charity and select Masicorp UK Ltd ("Masicorp UK") as their chosen charity. These Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws of England and Wales.

1. Eligibility

Participants must meet the minimum age requirements set by the event organiser. Unless otherwise specified:

- 16 years or over for 5 km, 10 km and half marathon events.
- 18 years or over for marathon events.

By registering for the event, you confirm that the age information you provide is accurate and complete.

2. Fundraising Commitment

By participating in an event, you commit to fundraising at least the minimum amount specified by Masicorp UK for the specific event.

Donations must be made directly to Masicorp's UK JustGiving profile (webpage) or event-specific Masicorp UK JustGiving webpage by no later than one week following the date of the event. Donations are regularly transferred from Masicorp UK to Masicorp, South Africa. These funds directly support the people and township of Masiphumelele.

Donors who are UK taxpayers may be able to Gift Aid their donations, subject to HMRC rules.

Unless expressly stated otherwise, all donations are non-refundable.

3. Health and Fitness

By entering, you confirm that you understand the physical nature of the event and are physically fit or will be fit by the last date of withdrawal and, to the best of your knowledge, will be able to safely complete the event within the cut-off time.

If you have any concerns about your health or fitness, you should seek advice from a qualified medical professional before entering and participating.

4. Participation is at Your Own Risk

Masicorp UK is not responsible for supervising participants during the event and accepts no responsibility for injuries, illness, loss or damage arising from participation, except where liability cannot lawfully be excluded. Nothing in these Terms and Conditions

excludes or limits liability for death or personal injury caused by negligence, fraud, or any other liability that cannot legally be excluded under the laws of England and Wales.

5. Event and Run for Charity Terms

The event is organised by the relevant event organiser and the charity entry portal is made available by Run For Charity.

Participants agree to comply with:

- all event rules and conditions;
- all safety instructions issued by the organiser;
- the Run For Charity Terms and Conditions; and
- all applicable laws and regulations in relation to the event and use of the Run for Charity Portal.

Masicorp UK is not responsible for the organisation, operation, cancellation or safety management of the event or any consequences of use of the Run for Charity portal.

6. Event Changes or Cancellation

The event organiser or Run For Charity may amend, postpone, cancel or alter an event. Masicorp UK is not responsible for such changes and cannot guarantee that entry fees or associated costs will be refunded. Further information and updates regarding changes or cancellations may be provided by the event organiser and Run For Charity.

Masicorp UK reserves the right to withdraw its charity entries from the event if, in its reasonable opinion, it deems such withdrawal necessary, for example due to concerns regarding event safety that arise after the charity entries are open and allocated.

7. Participant Withdrawal

Participants may withdraw or request a transfer of their place in accordance with the rules of the event organiser and Run For Charity.

Any administration charges or transfer fees imposed by the organiser or Run For Charity to the participant or Masicorp UK are the responsibility of the participant.

8. Photographs and Publicity

By participating, you consent to Masicorp UK using photographs, videos and other media from the event and for future promotional purposes. You may withdraw your consent at any time by emailing contact@masicorp.org.

9. Privacy

Masicorp UK will process your personal information in accordance with its Privacy Policy. Requests by participants to review their personal information may be done by emailing contact@masicorp.org.

10. Event Kit

Subject to availability and commitment to fundraising at least the minimum target amount, participants may be eligible to receive a Masicorp UK branded shirt or vest to wear during the event. Marathon and half marathon events will take preference for supply availability. Note, no kit will be provided for 5km & 10km events or fun runs of 5km or less.

11. Acceptance

By registering to participate in an event in support of Masicorp UK, you confirm that you have read, understood and agreed to these Terms and Conditions.
